



The Iowa General Assembly wrapped up its 2024 Regular Session in the early morning hours of April 20, 2024, with the Senate adjourning at 3:26 AM upon passing their Sine Die resolution. The House swiftly followed suit moments later. With the adoption of the Sine Die ("Without a Day") resolution, legislative activities have concluded until the 2nd Monday of January 2025, unless the Governor calls for a Special Session.

We extend our gratitude to the members of the INA Public Policy Committee and our dedicated lobbyist, Amy Campbell with The Advocacy Collaborative, for their unwavering commitment to monitoring Iowa's legislative landscape throughout this session. The final stretch leading up to the conclusion demanded tireless efforts, with last week especially characterized by extended days and nights. Amy Campbell and her team are diligently updating the [Bill Tracker](#) amidst the flurry of bills passed in the session's final 72-96 hours. We thank you for your patience during this process.
